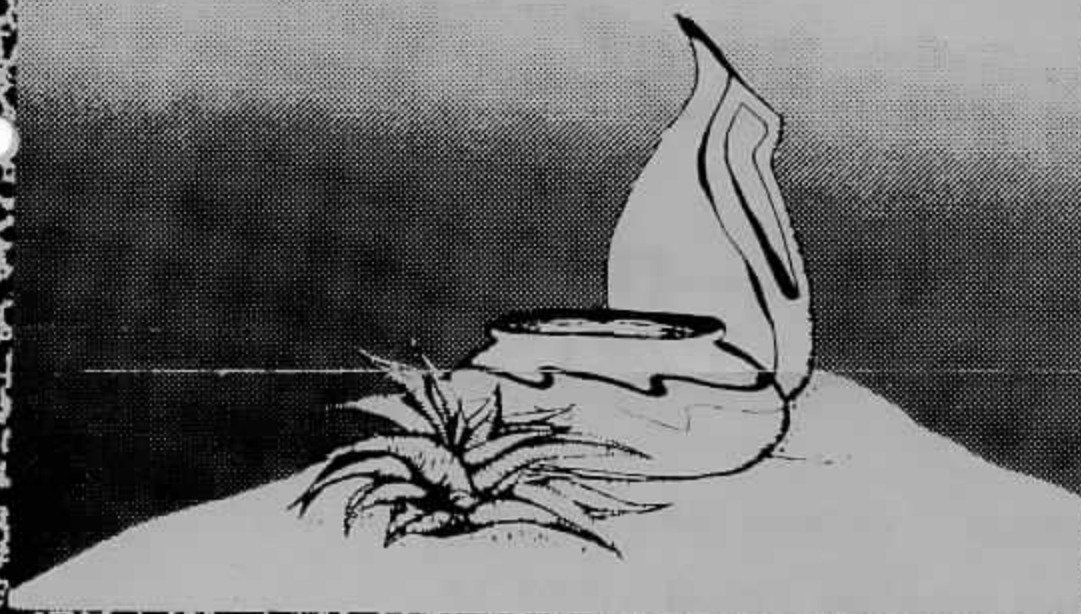
OTHER EVENTS
