WHAT HAS HAPPENED TO THE INTEREST IN OUR "CACTUS GARDEN"

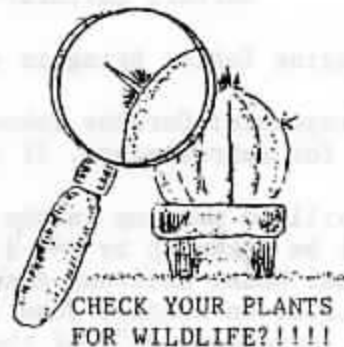
