Now would be a good time to consider joining the CSSA, as you would be eligible to attend the biennial convention scheduled for Auggust 5-10 in Scottsdale, AZ. Held in the heart of cactus country, this convention promises to be one of best ever. The Scottsdale Plaza Resort will be the most luxurious venue a CSSA convention has ever experienced. It's admottedly hot there in August which is why room rates are lower than normal at \$89 per night (normally going for \$500 or more). But everthing inside is air-conditioned, and you won't have to travel outside from location to location as in previous years. Several outstanding speakers are lined up including; Sheila Collenette, Chucj Hanson, John Lavranos, Len Newton, and the Fitz-Maurices. Plant vendors and the traditional rare plant auction will offer a tempting array of plants and plant related items. On 'Field day' trips will be offered to the Descrt Botancial Gardens, the Boyce Thompson Arboreteum, the Arizona Sonora Descrt Museum, and trip out into the descrt to see plants in habitat. You'll be wishing 6you could clone yourself. Throughout the convention there will be plenty of activities scheduled for non-cactophile spouces and children. Finally there will be a week long pre-convention tour to the Four Corners area, a region of spectacular scenic beauty and home to some of our choicest North American cacti.
