#### **Program:**

Maria introduced Keith Taylor who presented a program on “Chopped: Root Pruning 101.” He primarily grows caudiciform plants for show and sale. He demonstrated his root pruning and plant potting techniques of growing his plants “hard” to ultimately plant them in shallow pots. His soil mix is 20% decomposed granite and 80% pumice and he does not fertilize in order to slow down the growing. He makes unique, highly textured pots for his own use and sale.

His presentation included active questions and answers and concluded at 2:55pm.

Maria asked Vince to pick two names from the sprinkling can: one to help judge and the other to assist with selecting names for the door prize plants.
