There were 44 members in attendance. President Maria Capaldo called the meeting to order at 1:30pm in the South Coast Botanic Garden Auditorium. She welcomed attendees to the meeting and encouraged members to sign in with Nancy Sams who is helping with membership and put your name in the sprinkling can for a free plant later in the meeting.

Program:

Maria introduced Nick Renteria who presented a program on "Botanical Gardens of Thailand." Nick has travelled to Thailand extensively and had wonderful photos of the garden there.

Nick invited members to show their plants at the CSSA Show in June. He advised that complimentary tickets to the Show at the Huntington Botanical Gardens are available to our Society members. Mike Short sent an email to members with links. Volunteers who work at the Show get free admission.
