PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

IT'S SHOW TIME! Our Show & Sale Chair, Carol Knight and volunteer coordinator, Nancy Jengo are working very hard to ensure the event runs smoothly. I hope all members will come and enjoy themselves - bring a

friend. Don't forget your camera, as there will be many plants worthy of a photo. Please see the (repeat) article below and the (newly added) information on our website for assignments and set up information. If there is a job you can do and you haven't already signed up, please contact Nancy Jengo or myself. We still need lots of kitchen help on Sunday.

Show and Sale Information:

Set-Up: This year we will be setting up all the vendors in the main auditorium, the displays will be in the classrooms. We will start set-up on Friday, April 5th at noon. Entry to the rooms are available only through the main entrance since there is construction at the side and kitchen entrance.

Displays: Displays: Round tables will be in the classrooms for displays set up by our vendors and Society members. They can be either "Specimen" to show individual plants, or "Artistic" to show succulent plants in an artistic way in any medium. We ask members and visitors to vote on Saturday for their favorites. It's just a personal choice. On Sunday, the winners of Specimen and Artistic will each be awarded certificates-\$60 for first place, \$40 for second place and \$20 for third place to be spent at the Show and Sale only. In addition, society members who have a display table receive 4 Mini-show points.

Society Display Table: This is for Members of the Society to show off their special plants. Please bring your plants 12:00 - 4:00 PM on Friday or before 8:30 AM on Saturday. Print legibly on the entry slips. The Table Coordinator will give all plants a "health" check and if there are too many of one specie, the best or better one will get the space. You will get one Mini-show point for each of your plants on the table up to a total of four points. We won't leave plants that aren't picked up, but PLEASE pick them up after 4:00 PM Sunday. It might be a good idea to

put your name on the bottom of the pot because the entry slips will be collected at the end of the show.

Volunteering: If you are volunteering at the show on Saturday morning, please come early enough so you are ready for the public by 8:30. Bring your name tag and wear it so visitors can identify you as a Society member. Wear your society aprons or T shirt or buy a new one available in all sizes at the sale.

Food: The Society will provide mini croissant sandwiches on Saturday and Pizza on Sunday for volunteers and vendors. We ask Society members to bring in a side dish, salad, dessert or appetizer to supplement this. It is best to bring food in a container that can be stored overnight in the refrigerator for Sunday.

Kid's Planting Station: We will again have the planting station for kids. I think it will be a great way to get children involved and encourage more families to attend. Any amount of your cuttings are appreciated toward this event.

Reminders: Please collect newspapers to help with packing and boxes and bring them when you come.

Thank you in advance for all the work you do to make this a successful Show and Sale!

FRIDAY SETUP

Arrive Friday, April 5th at 1:00 to help arrange the tables and chairs. They will already be unfolded and out of the closet. Help put up signs and assist in the organization of show materials.

KITCHEN ORGANIZERS and SERVERS

There will be several shifts, Saturday and Sunday.

Morning needs to keep the hot water and coffee flowing.

Arrange the kitchen for breakfast bagels, etc. Put out snacks. Around 11:00 start arranging the lunch for volunteers and vendors. Put out utensils, plates, etc. Clean up after lunch. Late Saturday put leftovers in the refrigerator for Sunday.

TAG PULLERS

We need many people to help pull tags in different shifts. Tags are in the plants the buyers are purchasing. Pullers need to pull the tags, count them and make sure that number matches the number of plants to be purchased

HOSPITALITY/ T-SHIRTS

Volunteers will help with new memberships or sell T-

shirts or help with ballots for favorite Show table. You also will answer general questions and direct the public to the Show plants in the classrooms.

SOCIETY SALE TABLE

This is our society's sale table. These are plants society members have donated. We need volunteers to help keep an eye on the plants. Answer general questions about the plants and keep table looking nice.

PRESALE PLANT HOLDING AREA

These volunteers will help watch that buyers only take their plants and not pick and choose from other people's plants in the holding area. This can be a sitting job.

SOCIETY SHOW PLANT TABLE

The table needs to be set up with tablecloths and plant tags by Friday afternoon. (All are provided by the society.) Members can bring in their plants starting Friday afternoon. Saturday morning help arrange the plants on the table and make sure they are pest free.

CLEAN UP

At 4 PM Sunday we close the show/sale. We need volunteers to help take down signs, clean off tables, sweep and general clean up. Tables and chairs will be left in place. Garden personnel will take care of those.
